### **PLANS IN-WATER BOAT SHOW, MAY 11-13, 2007**

#### **North Myrtle Beach Intracoastal Waterway Marina Celebrates First Anniversary**

**NORTH MYRTLE BEACH, S.C. (May 1, 2007)** – The new Barefoot Resort Yacht Club will celebrate its first anniversary on May 11-13 with its 2nd Annual In-Water Boat Show presented by Premier Resorts. It will feature dozens of powerboats, displays of marine accessories, and live entertainment.

The event is open to the public and admission is \$5 for adults and free for children under 12. Hours are 10 a.m. – 6 p.m., Friday and Saturday; and 12 p.m. – 5 p.m. on Sunday. *The Carousels* will be performing live on DockSider's Grille deck on Friday and Saturday evenings, starting at 5 p.m.

The boat show will fill the 142-slip marina, offering a veritable flotilla of the latest craft from marine dealers and manufacturers. Boats on display will be the country's top brands including Boston Whaler, Cruiser, Four Winns, Mainship, Novatec, Pioneer, Polar,

Rampage, Regal, Rinker, Sea Ray Silverton, and Wellcraft.

The Barefoot Resort Boat Show will also feature financial, engine, generator, apparel, and educational exhibitors for experienced boaters and those interested in learning more about the activity.

The Barefoot Resort Yacht Club, one of the few new marinas to be built on the East Coast in 2006, is located on the west bank of the Intracoastal Waterway at milemarker 354. The state-of-the-art freshwater facility features slips from 33- to 53-feet, concrete floating docks, and an adjacent Ships Store, fuel and pump-out service. Boats up to 150 feet can also be accommodated.

The Yacht Club is located at the Barefoot Resort & Golf Resort with access to over 100 shops and restaurants at Barefoot Landing, located directly across the Intracoastal from the Marina. For more information log onto: [www.barefootresortclub.com](http://www.barefootresortclub.com).

The 120-seat Docksider's Grille, adjacent to the marina, features a full service bar and traditional coastal fare with an open-air view of the Intracoastal. It is one of the few local restaurants on the Waterway where boaters can arrive by private boat and dock at no charge for breakfast, lunch, cocktails or dinner. One unique feature of the restaurant's outside deck is a genuine Sir Rumford outdoor fireplace, patterned after the fireplace found in Thomas Jefferson's Monticello plantation.
